

STEPS AND PROCEDURES FOR APPEARING IN COMPUTER BASED TEST

Step 1: Login with your credentials in first window.

Step 2: Read the instructions and tick on the declarations, then Click on Start button.

Candidates are advised to read the following instructions carefully.

1. DO NOT PRESS ANY FUNCTION KEY ON KEYBOARD AT ANY TIME (i.e. F5-REFRESH, Ctrl, Alt, Enter, Tab, Shift etc.)
2. Each page contains one question and questions will appear one by one.
3. All questions are of **objective type** having multiple options. You have to answer by selecting the most appropriate one.
4. If you have selected any option and at any time you want to change the option of that question, please press the **Unmark Answer** and choose new answer.
5. On the right hand side of the screen, there is a panel showing all **attempted** questions and **not attempted** questions. **Attempted** question are in **Green colour**.
6. List of **attempted** and **not attempted** questions will be displayed separately on the screen. If you want to move to any particular question, please **click** on that question number.
7. **Clicking on the 'Submit' button means you have completed your online examination and you will not be able to make any changes to the answers chosen by you.**
8. Immediately upon pressing '**Submit**' button, your examination will be over.
9. **In case your Question paper page does not open after clicking on START button, please ensure that popup is enabled in the browser. Otherwise, please contact the Center Co-ordinator.**
